## History

The children will study Tudors.

The children will develop a chronologically secure knowledge of the Tudors whilst enjoying a range of cross-



## English

In the Autumn term Year 6 children will study a variety of text types, such as description, biographies and fiction genres.

They will focus on effective writing styles and examine the key features of each type of text. Underlying this, the children will revise their knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar.

## Maths

The Year 6 children will be consolidating and extending their knowledge and skills in Numeracy.

This will include negative number, division, factors and fractions. We will focus on subject specific vocabulary and relating maths to real life situations. Underlying this the children will continue to revise their times tables and arithmetic skills.

## D/T

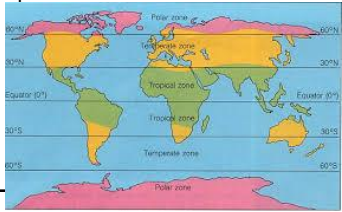
The first DT unit will focus on the use of textiles.

## Geography

During the Autumn term the geography topic will focus on Climate Zones.



## PE

Dance:  
The children will explore, improvise and combine movement ideas fluently and effectively. They will also evaluate and refine their work.

The children will be doing Invasion Games weekly.

## Music

The children will develop an understanding of the history of music and will study great composers from each phase.

Each child will be encouraged to respond to pieces of well known music by drawing a visual interpretation of the song.

## Science

The topics this term are based on the biology aspect of Science. The children will be studying two topics, exploring evolution and also inheritance.



## Computing

Throughout Year Six the children will develop Digital Literacy through the use of a range of programs and internet services. They will explore all of the five core strands over the course of the year:

- Programming
- E-safety
- Technology in our lives
- Data handling
- Multimedia

## RE + PSHE

RE  
The children think about the beliefs, traditions and cultural celebrations of the Jewish faith.

PSHE:  
The class will hold regular discussions to consider how to deal with new beginnings and getting on/falling out with friends.

## Art

Children will use a sketch book and a variety of materials to create cave art. They will work with textured surfaces to evaluate the effect they can have on the outcome of a piece.

During this term children will look at Pop Art.
