

Home Learning Menu Term 5 - Marvellous Movement

Teachers provide a Home learning Menu at the start of each new term as a part of the Termly Curriculum Overview. We ask that children select at least one activity from the menu and either share on seesaw or bring into class during the last week of the term to share with the class and to celebrate.

Thinking as a Writer	Write an acrostic poem using the word 'river'.	Write a list of geographical features in Keynsham.	Describe an area of Keynsham.	Create a poster about your favourite place in the South- West.
Thinking as a Designer	Follow a recipe to create something healthy.	Practise grating and peeling fruit and vegetables safely.	Create a poster about food hygiene.	Record the different places your food comes from, e.g. from a farm, grown at home.
Thinking as a Scientist	Draw and label parts of a plant.	Look at different kinds of seeds and describe what is similar and different.	Investigate growing cress in light and dark conditions.	Take 3 different seeds, plant them and describe what you see when they grow.
