

Home Learning Menu Term 5 - Incredible Invaders

Teachers provide a Home learning Menu at the start of each new term as a part of the Termly Curriculum Overview. We ask that children select at least one activity from the menu and either share on seesaw or bring into class during the last week of the term to share with the class and to celebrate.

Thinking as a Writer	Write a letter home to family/friends as though you are a soldier who has been sent to war.	Write a recount as though you are a Roman Soldier who has fought in the Colosseum.	Write a report as though you have spent time in a Roman soldier's camp.	Write a story about fighting alongside a Roman soldier.
Thinking as a Designer	Create a weaving using wool or ribbon.	Fix a piece of clothing using sewing techniques.	Upcycle a toy or piece of clothing using buttons, beads, or sequins.	Create a labelled diagram explaining the materials used in an item or Roman or Viking clothing.
Thinking as a Scientist	Create different shadow figures.	Record different sounds and describe their pitch and amplitude.	Create a poster about the dangers of looking at direct sunlight.	Record how your shadow changes over the course of a day.
