<p>Design some Christmas wrapping paper – can you use a repeating pattern?</p>		<p>Christmas is a time to think about ways to be kind and helpful to other people. Find a way that you can help someone in your family.</p>	
<p>If you have anyone in your family who remembers either of the World Wars, ask them to tell you about them. They may even have some photos you could look at.</p>		<p>Find out how different countries around the world celebrate Christmas.</p>
