Our ‘theme’ during term 2 has a focus on Celebrations. **If** your child would like to extend their learning at home, they could engage in one of the following ideas (or choose one of their own). Please upload a picture/video of the activity onto Tapestry by Monday 14th December so we can share your child’s learning with the rest of the class.

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| Use playdough or collage materials to make a pretend birthday cake | Find a recipe to make birthday cup cakes. |
| Look at photos of you on different birthdays – how have you celebrated your birthdays? | Use lego to make a pretend bonfire or birthday cake. |
| Paint or draw some firework pictures – you could add some glitter if you like!! | Make a birthday card to send to a friend or family member. |
| Ask your parents/grandparents how they used to celebrate their birthdays – did they do different things to what you do now? | Look at a calendar – can your adult help you find and write on the birthdays of people in your family and your friends? |
| Design some Christmas wrapping paper – can you use a repeating pattern? | Christmas is a time to think about ways to be kind and helpful to other people. Find a way that you can help someone in your family. |
| If you have anyone in your family who remembers either of the World Wars, ask them to tell you about them. They may even have some photos you could look at. | Find out how different countries around the world celebrate Christmas. |
