

Year R Home Learning Menu – Wonderful World!

Our 'theme' during term 4 has a focus on 'Our Wonderful World'. **If** your child would like to extend their learning at home, they could engage in one of the following ideas (or choose one of their own) and then upload it to Tapestry so we can all share it on the last week of term. Please ensure it is uploaded by Monday 29th March.

<p><u>Subtraction stories</u> There are 10 seeds waiting to grow in a flowerpot. If 4 seeds start to grow, how many seeds would still be waiting to grow? You could use your fingers or draw a picture to help you. There are 9 ladybirds on a leaf. If 6 fly away, how many would be left on the leaf? You could use your fingers or draw pictures to help you. Ask your adult to make up some more for you to try.</p>	<p><u>Bug Hotel</u> Use natural materials to make a bug hotel.</p> 
<p><u>Model minibeast</u> Try making a model minibeast! You could use playdough or empty cardboard boxes and tubes. Empty yoghurt pots or plastic bottles could be used. Maybe you could make a butterfly, a worm, a ladybird or a spider.</p>	<p><u>Minibeast list</u> Try to write a list of as many minibeasts as you can think of. Can you draw a picture to go with each one?</p>
<p><u>Flower list</u> Try to write a list of as many flowers as you can think of. Can you draw a picture to go with each one?</p>	<p><u>Minibeast stories</u> Have you got any stories or information books about minibeasts at home? Ask an adult to read one to you. You could draw and/or write about your favourite part.</p>
<p><u>Recycling</u> Find out what things can be recycled – can you make this into a poster to encourage everyone to recycle?</p>	<p><u>Leaves</u> If you get a chance, try to collect as many different shaped leaves as you can. Can you name any of the plants/trees that they came from?</p>
<p><u>Painting</u> Draw or paint a picture of some flowers. What colours do you need?</p>	<p><u>Weather watcher</u> Try to keep a weather diary for a week (or longer if you wish). Draw or write about what the weather is doing each day.</p>
