### Writing Activities

<b>Write a short story set in the Viking time period</b>	<b>Write a diary entry from the perspective of an Anglo-Saxon on their journey to Britain.</b>	<b>Write a play script for a Viking funeral</b>
Success criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clear structure (beginning, middle and end)</li><li>• Past tense</li><li>• Third person</li><li>• Fronted adverbials</li><li>• Adventurous vocabulary</li><li>• Use inverted commas for a short piece of dialogue</li><li>• Use 'show not tell' – remember the five senses</li><li>• Ellipsis for suspense (...)</li></ul>	Success criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dear diary...</li><li>• Date</li><li>• Use paragraphs</li><li>• Include adjectives/adverbs</li><li>• Use expanded noun phrases</li><li>• Commas</li><li>• Pronouns for cohesion (he/she/they)</li><li>• Include a variety of punctuation (: -)</li><li>• Technical language (Angles, Saxons, Jutes, Kingdoms...)</li></ul>	Success criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use speaker in margin</li><li>• Use colon to introduce speech</li><li>• Include stage directions</li><li>• New line for new speaker</li><li>• Use adverbs to describe actions</li></ul>

### Purple Mash

Your task this week is to write a review for a possible future visitor to the city.

Instructions to complete this task are below:

- Click on the addition symbol in green to find an appropriate photo to add to the section.

- On the left hand side, there are a list of topic areas e.g. shopping.

### Maths Topic – Time

- Children need to be able to read and write the time from an analogue, 12- and 24- hour clock including using roman numerals.
- Discuss with them the number of seconds in a minute, and the number of days each month, year and leap year.
- Please practise telling the time with your child on both an analogue clock (clock with hands) and a digital clock.
- Discuss with them what the 12- and 24- hour clock look like and discuss their similarities/ differences.
