<p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Newspaper name</li><li>• Headline with alliteration</li><li>• An introduction with what, where, when, who, why</li><li>• Information about the main events in chronological order</li><li>• Written in 3rd person and in the past tense</li><li>• Witness statements using direct speech</li><li>• A concluding paragraph to explain what might happen next</li></ul>	<p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use adjectives</li><li>• Use adverbs</li><li>• Use the 3 different senses to say how it made you feel.(see, hear, smell)</li><li>• Commas in a list</li><li>• Use similes</li></ul>	<p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Past tense</li><li>• First person</li><li>• Fronted adverbials</li><li>• Use paragraphs</li><li>• Commas</li><li>• Pronouns for cohesion (he/she/they)</li><li>• Include a variety of punctuation (!?....)</li><li>• Inverted commas for speech</li></ul>
