Year 1 had great fun in DT measuring, cutting, gluing and decorating to produce tube craft animals. Well done Year 1!



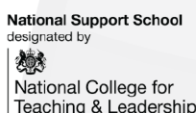
Year 5

If the children need to fill up their water bottle or are unable to bring a water bottle to school the teacher will have a jug of fresh water.
