Have an Easter egg hunt! Ask a grown-up to hide some Easter eggs for you to find. How many eggs can you find?	Decorate some hard-boiled eggs, to make them bright and colourful. You could use pens or paint and add some extra decorations, such as stickers, feathers, pom-poms or googly eyes.	Make some Easter treats to share with your family. You could make cakes or biscuits and decorate them too!
Make an Easter basket to keep your Easter eggs safe. You could use empty cardboard boxes and add some decorations too.	Have an egg and spoon race at home with your family. Take pictures to share when school re-opens.	Draw or paint an Easter picture – you could draw some Easter eggs, flowers, chicks or even the Easter bunny!
Write an Easter poem or sentences about Easter.	At Easter time lots of flowers start growing in the ground and trees. Go for a walk and write a list of what plants and flowers you can see growing.	Write an Easter story.
