Explore the Tudors and Victorians by

Investigate and interpret the past

- Use sources of information to form testable hypotheses about the past.
- Refine lines of enquiry as appropriate.

Build an overview of world history

- Give a broad overview of life in Britain from medieval until the Tudor and Stuarts times.
- Understand how rich and poor were divided in medieval times.
- Describe how communities and the influence of religion in Britain has changed over time.
- Victorians – look at the lives of rich and poor and draw comparisons today.

Understand chronology

- Identify periods of rapid change in history and contrast them with times of relatively little change.
- Understand the concepts of continuity and change over time, representing them, along with evidence, on a timeline.
- Link events, artefacts and historical figures on a timeline using dates.

Sculpture

- Show life-like qualities and real-life proportions or, if more abstract, provoke different interpretations.
Use tools to carve and add shapes, texture and pattern.
- Combine visual and tactile qualities.
- Use frameworks (such as wire or moulds) to provide stability and form.

- Comment on artworks with a fluent grasp of visual language.
