## Celebrations

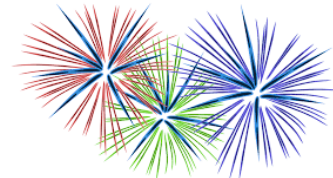


## Physical Development

Gymnastics—rolling, jumping and balancing in a variety of ways. Use low level equipment to travel and sequence movements

Games—practise games skills in small groups or with a partner. Use a range of equipment (with Sports Coaches).

Use stories to learn about different festivals

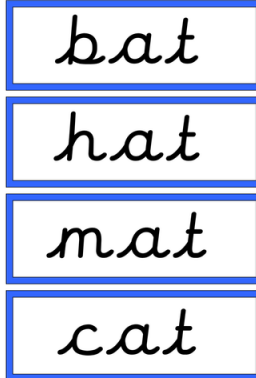


## Literacy

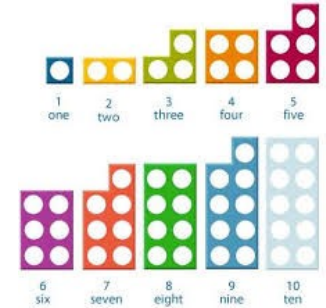
